Mr. Mayor and Council, I would have shown up for today's meeting, but unfortunately, the political climate has not made it possible for me to feel safe in attending a city council meeting. The week before last, one of our city council members phoned in a threat to a local citizen that was aimed at me. A police report was filed by the third party and it was determined that the threat did not meet the criminal definition needed to warrant a criminal investigation, but none-the-less, it was a warning, that has been documented and one that I take very seriously.

We are here today to discuss the creation of a Diversity Council and I have already gone on record as supporting the idea and endeavor to create such a Council or Commission. I have also gone on record as saying the Statue should be removed from its present place of prominence on the McKinney Square.

I will also say one other thing. No man should be judged by one or two events or positions one may take in his or her life span, overlooking any other good things, done. That is what we are doing here and if that is the standard by which we judge others in their public service, then so be it.

Let the record show, Mr. Mayor, that some of us have willingly overlooked the past criminal conduct of one city council members sitting with us today, because we once saw hope in his endeavors and he assured us that he was a changed man. We have come to expect much of our elected leaders. Some raise to the occasion and some do not. Sadly, Governor Throckmortoin did not and in my honest opinion, neither has Mr. Shemwell.
