

- In the corporative agreement Frisco ISD will hire, equip, and train the crossing guards, while the City of McKinney will reimburse Frisco ISD for the associated cost for placement for the crossing guards at intersections designated by the McKinney Engineering Department.
- This Interlocal Agreement is a one-year agreement with an additional five (5) one-year annual renewals with no action necessary by either governing body. The number and location of the crossing guards may change annually as new school campuses or neighborhoods are added.
- This Interlocal Agreement is similar to the previous agreement developed in 2006. However, this proposed agreement allows for the adjustment of the crossing guards annually as needed.
- This Agreement was uses to develop the interlocal agreement with McKinney ISD, Allen ISD, and Prosper ISD.

FINANCIAL SUMMARY:

- The City of McKinney will reimburse Frisco Independent School District for costs related to the services provided with the Program. Any equipment provided by the City of McKinney is not subject to reimbursement such as, but not limited to, traffic cones.
- The total reimbursable cost to Frisco ISD for the school year beginning August 10, 2022 to May 19, 2023 is \$ 110,328.25.
- Funding for the Agreement will be provided in the Engineering Operating Budget.
