



- The City-wide Traffic Count Program will obtain 24-hour traffic count data for up to 380 locations along arterial roadways and neighborhood collector roadways. This program will also include classification counts in 13 locations along these same roadways.
- Kimley-Horn and Associates, Inc. was one of ten firms selected as part of 21-19RFQ - On-Call Traffic Engineering Services that was approved by City Council on February 2, 2021.
