**ITEM SUMMARY:**

- This Resolution authorizes the City Manager to execute an Interlocal Agreement with DFW Airport to provide Aircraft Rescue and Firefighter Training (ARFF) consistent with FAA requirements.
- This Interlocal Agreement will become effective immediately upon its signing, and continue indefinitely until terminated by one of the parties.

**BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

- The McKinney Fire Department provides emergency response as needed for aircraft in and around McKinney National Airport and Aero Country Airport.
- DFW Airport Department of Public Safety is the only FAA-recognized provider for Aircraft Rescue and Fire Fighting (ARFF) training in the vicinity that meets the needs of the MFD for initial ARFF certification and aircraft live fire training.
- This Agreement is required for participation in the training activities.

**FINANCIAL SUMMARY:**
