ITEM SUMMARY:

- As a result of House Bill 1819 adopted by the Texas Legislature and signed into effect on September 1, 2023, juvenile curfew ordinances are no longer enforceable.
- Article VIII, of Chapter 70 "Curfew Hours" of the Code of Ordinances, City of McKinney, Texas ("McKinney Code"), falls under this definition.
- The proposed ordinance will repeal and delete this Article and Sections of the McKinney Code.
