ITEM SUMMARY:

- Young Actors Guild of McKinney is requesting \$3,000 for the promotion of their 2024-2025 season performances including Trap (October), Pride & Prejudice (February), Romeo and Juliet (April), and Charlotte's Web (July 2024).
- Prices per show are \$15 for general admission and \$12 for youth and seniors over 65.
- Total expected attendance for all shows is 1,500 with about 10% coming from outside McKinney.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

- The Young Actors Guild of McKinney was established in 2009 as part of McKinney Repertory Theatre to empower children and teens by involving them in all aspects of theatre production.
- Youth gain experience in onstage performances and behind-the-scenes roles including set design, stage direction, and technical operations.

FINANCIAL SUMMARY:

- MCDC's allocated Promotional and Community Event grant funding for FY 24 in the amount of \$200,000 -- \$100,000 for Cycle I applicants and \$100,000 for Cycle II applicants.

- Total grant funds available for Cycle II, including reappropriation of unused promotional funds from FY23, total \$154,606.
- This is the first time Young Actors Guild of McKinney has applied for a grant from MCDC.
