**ITEM SUMMARY:**

- the City Council has certain responsibilities for redistricting the City's councilmember districts under federal and state law including Amendments 14 and 15 to the United States Constitution, U.S.C.A. and Section 2 of the Voting Rights Act, 52 U.S.C.A. §10301; City Charter Chapter III, Section 10; and Tex. Gov't Code Ann. §§ 2058.001 and 2058.002
- It is necessary to provide for the orderly consideration and evaluation of redistricting plans which may come before the Council
- These guidelines relate to persons who have specific redistricting plans they wish the City Council to consider.
