ITEM SUMMARY:

- Heritage Guild of Collin County is requesting a grant in the amount of \$15,000 for advertising, marketing and promotion of the following fall 2022 Chestnut Square events: Farmers Market, Bar Wars, Murder Mystery, Legends of McKinney Ghost Walk and Holiday Tour of Homes.
- The events will be held during the period from August through December 2022.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

- The mission of Heritage Guild of Collin County is to celebrate community, preserve history and inspire the future.
- HGCC was organized more than 40 years ago.
- HGCC supports Chestnut Square Historic Village - a McKinney Museum and tourist destination offering diverse programs and activities throughout the year.

FINANCIAL SUMMARY:

- MCDCC's annual allocation for Promotional and Community Event grants is \$200,000.

Remaining budget is \$101,000.

- MCDC awarded a FY 22 Cycle I Promotional and Community Event grant to Heritage Guild of Collin County totaling \$12,000.
