### ITEM SUMMARY:

- This Resolution authorizes formal rejection of all proposals under Solicitation 22-38RFP Decontamination Trailer.

### BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

- The City issued a solicitation (22-38RFP) for a Decontamination Trailer on May 1, 2022.
  - Advertised in the McKinney Courier Gazette and Celina Record.
  - Posted on McKinney TV.
  - 199 matching eBid supplier notifications which included seven (7) Historically Underutilized Business (HUB) suppliers.

- Out of 199 supplier notifications, one (1) proposal was received on June 16, 2022.
- During the review process of the submission, it was determined to be \$60,000 over the grant amount received for the purchase of the trailer. McKinney Fire determined the budget was not available to use to cover the cost of the trailer.
