## ITEM SUMMARY:

- In accordance with MPFC Bylaws,
  - The officers of the Corporation shall be a President, a Vice President, a Secretary, and a Treasurer, and such other officers as the Board may from time to time elect or appoint.
  - Terms of office shall not exceed two (2) years, provided that an officer may be reelected to such position by the Board of Directors.
  - All officers must be a member of the Board.
