ITEM SUMMARY:

- This Resolution authorizes formal rejection of all bids under Solicitation 24-26CC Downton Dumpster Enclosure

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

- The City issued an Invitation to Bid (24-26CC) for the Downtown Dumpster Enclosure on December 3, 2023.
 - Advertised in the McKinney Courier Gazette and Celina Record
 - Posted on McKinney TV
 - 1058 matching eBid supplier notifications which included 52 Historically Underutilized

Business (HUB) suppliers.

- Out of 1058 supplier notifications, two (2) bids were received and opened by Procurement Services on December 21, 2023. The following is a summary of the bids:

| Bid No. | Bidder | Bid Amount |
|----------------|--------------------------------|-------------------|
| 1 | APR Group, Inc. | \$293,456.00 |
| 2 | Crossland Construction Company | \$404,100.00 |

- The Engineer's Opinion of Probable Construction Cost (OPCC) was \$250,000 and the bids received exceeded the budgeted amount for this project. The Facilities Construction division has elected to reject all bids.
