ITEM SUMMARY:

- Collin County History Museum is requesting a grant in the amount of \$11,500 for 2025 events including:
 - Night at the Museum on February 15 (\$7 per ticket);
 - WWE-Launch of Haystack Calhoun’s Exhibit on March 15 (\$7 per ticket);
 - Wedding Bliss from Days Gone By on June 14 (\$25 per ticket);
 - Shelby Exhibit on September 15 (\$35 per car); and
 - Honoring Our Veterans on November 8 (free).
- General admission to the museum remains free.
- Anticipated attendance is 100-300 per event.
- Museum hosts about 600 guests each month.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

- The mission of the Collin County History Museum is to preserve and honor the past, connect

with the present and embrace the future.

- The organization is committed to the collection and preservation of the rich heritage and history of the people and events that helped shape McKinney.
- The exhibit will promote Heritage Tourism in McKinney.

FINANCIAL SUMMARY:

- MCDC's allocation for Promotional and Community Event grants for FY 25 is \$250,000 -- \$125,000 for Cycle I applicants and \$125,000 for Cycle II applicants.
- MCDC provided a Promotional and Community Event grant in FY 24 in the amount of \$13,000 for the advertising, marketing and promotion of the launch of the Created in Collin exhibit and associated events.
