- The Texas Chapter of the APA has presented the City of McKinney with an Award for Planning Excellence for the ONE McKinney 2040 Comprehensive Plan.
 - This award recognizes comprehensive plans that advance the science and art of planning.

 - Two cities received this award for their comprehensive plans, the City of McKinney and the City of Boerne.

staff and the support exhibited by the City Council and Planning and Zoning Commission.
