ITEM SUMMARY:

- The proposed Resolution authorizes the application for and acceptance of, if awarded, a Texas Parks and Wildlife Department Community Outdoor Outreach Program Grant for a kayak program.
- This grant would deliver a kayaking program that will meet the needs of all ages, but would focus on the following groups; active adults aged 50 and above, afterschool children, special needs populations, and females.
- The Parks and Recreation Department is requesting grant assistance in the amount of \$16,000.
- This grant fully reimburses costs to the City up the award amount. No matching funds are required.
- The application submission deadline to Texas Parks & Wildlife for consideration is November 6, 2020, with an award announcement in Spring of 2021.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION:

Kayaking in McKinney has been a frequently requested program. In the past McKinney offered
